

Your client has approached me in the hope of their dog receiving a canine massage treatment. I am qualified through the *Therapeutic Canine Massage Diploma*, a course ran by the renowned Canine Massage Therapy Centre Ltd, and externally accredited with Ascentis; a national awarding body, approved by Ofqual; the regulator of qualifications, examinations and assessments in England and vocational qualifications in Northern Ireland.

Treatment - *Initial treatment* involves gait and postural analysis, assessment of past medical history, daily lifestyle and diet, a full body palpation, and full body treatment. *Subsequent treatments*, should they be deemed necessary, will be approximately 1 hour long, and again involve a full body treatment. I am happy to provide treatment summaries upon request.

Please note that I will not be manipulating joints or the skeleton as part of my work and will be concentrating purely on the application of safe, structured massage techniques that may help issues such as strains, trigger points, spasms and myofascial issues by working upon the muscular system.
